Subject: Molasses based Distillery (30 KLPD), Expansion of Sugar Unit (2500 TCD to 3500 TCD) and Co-generation Power Plant (18 MW) at Village & Tehsil: Walwa, District: Sangli, Maharashtra by M/s Padmabushan Krantiveer Dr Nagnathanna Nayakawadi Hutatma Kisanahir Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana Ltd. – reg. Extension of Validity of EC.

This is in continuation of this Ministry's letter referred above and your letter under reference, wherein you have requested for extension of validity of aforesaid environmental clearance (EC) letter for another term. This Ministry has examined the above project in light of amendment notification SO 1141 (E) dated 29th April, 2015 for extension of validity of environmental clearance, wherein validity period of environmental clearance has been increased to seven years from five years.

2. The proposal referred above was placed before the Reconstituted Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry) in its 17th, 21st and 44th meetings held during 18th-19th March, 2014, 30th July, 2014 to 1st August, 2014 and 20th -21st July, 2015. The Committee recommended the extension of validity of existing environmental clearance till 16.09.2017.

3. The Ministry accepts the recommendation of the REAC (Industry) and extends the validity of the Environmental Clearance letter no. J-11011/661/2007-IA II (I) dated 17th September, 2007 till 16.09.2017 subject to compliance of specific and general conditions.

4. ESP shall be provided to boiler of Co-generation Power Plant to control particulate emissions.

5. Spent wash generation from molasses based distillery shall not exceed 8 Kl/Kl of alcohol. Molasses based distillery will be treated in bio-methanation plant followed by bio-composting with press mud to achieve 'Zero' discharge. Spentlees and Utilities effluent shall be treated and recycled/reused in process. No effluent shall be discharged outside the premises and 'Zero' discharge shall be maintained.

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6. Automatic /online monitoring system (24x7 monitoring devices) for flow measurement and relevant pollutants in the treatment system to be installed. The data to be made available to the respective SPCB and in the Company's website.
7. Process effluent/any wastewater shall not be allowed to mix with storm water. Storm water drain shall be passed through guard pond.
8. Company shall ensure the quality and marketability of bio-compost fertilizer produced by standard labeling such as 'AGMARK' etc.
9. All other conditions stipulated in the environmental clearance letter no. J-11011/661/2007-IA II (I) dated 17th September, 2007 shall remain the same.
10. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
